

Campership Application

Thank you for your interest in the Bar 717 Ranch. For more than 90 years we have provided children the opportunity to join our large Ranch camp family here in the beautiful mountains of northern California. As a small, family-owned business, participant fees support the Ranch and all of our summer programs. We recognize that the cost of attending a session may be beyond the reach of many families, but our goal has always been that every child who wants to should be able to attend a session of camp.

To help us achieve that goal, the Bar 717 Ranch Campership Fund was created in 1980. The Fund provides tuition assistance to families who would not otherwise be able to afford a session of Camp Trinity for their child. The Campership Committee of the Bar 717 Ranch Advisory Board coordinates an annual fundraising campaign. Contributions to the Fund come from camp families, alumni, current and former staff, individuals, foundations, and even our campers. During past summers, campers have split firewood to be sold locally with the proceeds donated so a deserving child could attend camp in the future.

Camperships are awarded based on financial need and as such, we ask that all applicants do their best to truly assess their ability to contribute to camp tuition. The mission of our Campership program is to enable campers to attend whose families have no other means of sending their child to camp. If you have support from other family members or friends who are willing to contribute to your child's tuition, please consider that when completing your application.

Helpful guidelines:

- Camperships are available for any session, but not for Family Camp.
- Camperships are only available for one session.
- Campership awards are based on financial need. Full and partial camperships are available.
- We are only able to offer one Campership per family.
- Once a Campership has been granted, we will commit to a similar award for three consecutive summers. A new application and financial documentation will be required each year to verify need.

If your child receives a Campership, we would very much appreciate hearing from you, or your child, about their experience at camp. A note, letter, or email recounting their favorite activities, adventures, or memorable moments can be a tremendous help with future fundraising efforts.

A summer camp experience includes new friendships, wonder, fun, challenges, and growth. We hear all the time from kids that "Camp is the one place I can really be myself," and "Camp is my home away from home." There is no better feeling than making that experience a reality. We look forward to reviewing your application.

To apply for a Campership, please complete and return the following to the Ranch office:

- A completed Campership Application (including a short essay from the camper).
- Documentation of financial need:
 - o IRS Form 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ from most recent year
 - W-2 Forms (or other records of money earned) for all income earners who support the child applicant.



- o In some cases we may request additional financial information. We will contact you if this is necessary.
- Information regarding any unique circumstances not reflected in the application materials. The more information you can provide, the easier it is for us to make decisions that are consistent with the goals of the program.
