Our Grounds Maintenance and Irrigation staff member is responsible for maintaining our domestic and irrigation water systems, maintaining the grounds and lawns, managing trash, assisting the kitchen with food pickups, and working with the ranch crew as needed.

Qualifications:

- Minimum age of 18 by June 2024
- Possession of a valid Driver's License
- Accepting of diversity in culture, race, sexual orientation, religion, gender identity, and ethnicity.
- Strong communication skills with children, peers, and supervisors.
- Ability to work collaboratively as part of a team.
- Ability to seek and accept supervision and guidance.
- Enthusiasm, good judgment, patience, adaptability and self-control.
- Able to be a resident at camp from at least June 2, 2024 to at least August 17, 2024, with the option to extend on either end.
- All camp staff must demonstrate proof of receiving a COVID-19 vaccination.

Hours and Compensation:

- Full time (40 hours/week - work hours vary depending on the camp schedule)
- Compensation dependent on experience, \$16-18/hour
- Benefits are not available for this position, but meals and housing are provided
